It is always a pleasure to hear from you. We have already checked with our records and we are unable to find the statement you ask us to verify which is attributed to Ellen White in the Bible Echo of January 1, 1888. There is an E. G. White article in this issue, but it does not relate to this subject. We have also checked other articles in the January issue of the Bible Echo and do not find these words in any article.

There are two statements from Ellen G. White along this line which will be of interest to you in this connection. One is found in the General Conference Bulletin and the other in the Bible Echo of 1886. I'm inclined to think that the words you sent to us for verification is someone's memory of this 1886 statement. Anyway, here they are.

"Although God has ceased His works in creating, He is constantly employed in upholding and using as His servants the things which He had made." --GCB, Feb. 16, 1897, page 74.

"God has finished His creative work, but His energy is still exerted in upholding the objects of His creation." --Bible Echo, January 1886.
