Thank you for your letter asking about the question of infants. You may be interested to know that this statement found in Selected Messages, Book 2, page 260, is a portion of a letter that Ellen White wrote to her twin sister. You may not know that Ellen White's twin sister never became a Seventh-day Adventist. In this letter Ellen White was urging that she give her heart to the Lord and become a member of the remnant church. She never did.

This statement would apparently indicate that there will be some children in heaven whose parents will not be there. This is the only statement we know of of this nature. It is apparent that there will be infants in heaven that have not had the opportunity of choosing to serve the Lord. We perhaps can go no further than this. The Lord will have to decide in each of these cases.

Thank you for your letter. I hope these few comments will be of help to you in your study. May the Lord continue to bless you as you seek to serve Him.
