A \$3,500,000 Endowment Fund

What rejoicing it would bring to our hearts if it should be announced that some one had given our denomination an endowment fund for our schools of \$3,500,000! This invested at 5 per cent would bring in \$175,000 annually for our educational work.

Have we ever stopped to think that such an endowment has been made if we will only go out and collect the interest? If each church member in North America would sell one copy, and each laborer would sell two copies, of "Christ's Object Lessons" yearly, it would produce for our schools approximately the same amount as would 5 per cent interest on an endowment fund of \$3,500,000. When Mrs. E. G. White dedicated the book to our educational work, she gave us a much larger endowment than we sometimes realize. Our annual February campaign is simply for collecting the interest. E.
