Dear Brother

You have asked two questions: One, does Sister White say that there would be later translations of the Bible? The answer to this is that she does not discuss this question, and we have no information on this point from her.

The second question is, does she say that only the King James Version should be preached from the Seventh-day Adventist pulpits? No; she does not make any such statement. She herself drew from several versions of the Bible. I am enclosing a document dealing with this point, and I think it will furnish an answer to your question. You will observe on page 6 there is a statement from her son, W. C. White, in which she discusses the Revised Version, and presents counsel which was given to him personally by Sister White concerning other versions to be used in preaching.
