Before me is a copy of the little book "The Sanctified Life". In reading the introduction by the Trustees of the White Publications, concerning this book, the following statements appear.

"Under the general title of 'Sanctification' there appeared in the early issues of the REVIEW AND HERALD for 1881 a series of eleven helpful articles from the pen of Ellen G. White..."

"In the same decade the eleven articles were drawn together and published as a pamphlet..."

"In 1937...this material was again reissued in its entirety... to make the present volume...but with no change in textual matter..."

Two questions come to mind that would help me greatly in my study if you would be so kind as to share with me the answers.

NUMBER ONE: In the REVIEW AND HERALD ARTICLES, it presents ten of the eleven articles mentioned by the Trustees. Where might one find the missing article?

NUMBER TWO: In going through the ten articles in the REVIEW AND HERALD and comparing them with the book "The Sanctified Life" it is apparent that chapter eight or article (8) was left out. Why? In reading over this article one could hardly say it was redundant. It's title is "The Law of God the Standard of True Sanctification".

As a minister of the church, it may be well that some insight is given concerning the questions above should the questions come up in the minds of my people. In other words, what should I tell them?
