Dear Brother Degering:

In your letter, written December 12, you ask if we have any material in addition to what appears in Volume 3 on the services which should be provided for the blind, or related to the work of the blind. I would direct you to the book, Welfare Ministry, pages 239 to 242, where you will find two statements which do not appear in the Testimonies.

I have asked Miss Mount, my research assistant, to give some study to this question, and she has come up with two paragraphs drawn from E. G. White manuscripts which have a bearing on our relationship to the blind. I do not know how much they may be worth. These have not been released for general distribution, but I am sending them to you with the request that you read them, and if you feel that you would like to have them, and they would be of some service, we will arrange for their release.

Please do not copy these, and please send the originals back to me. I do not wish to place these before the Trustees and the Officers of the General Conference for release unless there is a definite feeling that they will be of service and you wish their release. I am sure that you will understand my position in this, and will honor my request.

This is about the extent of materials which we are able to turn up here in our office as they relate to the work for the blind.
