Dear Brother

I wish to thank you for your letter of recent date addressed to Elder Arthur White, but inasmuch as Elder White has not yet returned from Europe, may I give you what we have found to help you in the subject under consideration.

Some days ago we sent you quotations from Elder F. M. Wilcox's articles in the Review and Herald of 1944 on whether or not a Seventh-day Adventist should do night watchman's work on the Sabbath in a Seventh-day Adventist institution or a non-Adventist institution.

Enclosed you will find an article on the ingathering work. It took us quite a while to get this copy of the Gazette for no file is kept here in this office with extra copies, but in the April, 1948 Gazette, beginning on page 17, you have a brief history of the story of the ingathering work. Sister White's relationship to that ingathering work is mentioned in the article.

Aside from that we do not have anything in the writings of Ellen G. White of a specific nature on the ingathering work. We have considerable instruction and counsel concerning the accepting of gifts and donations from non-Adventists.
