

**Know all Men by these Presents,**  
That I Samuel Lang of Palmyra in the County  
of Somerset & State of Maine yeoman

In consideration of Six hundred dollars  
paid by John White of Town County & State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge) do hereby give, grant, sell and  
convey unto the said White a certain piece or parcel  
of land situated in Palmyra being the farm  
on which I the said Lang now live and the south  
part of the land formerly located and designated  
for the first settled minister in said Palmyra  
bounded as follows viz Beginning at the south  
~~thence east~~ west corner of said land thence  
east on land located for the use of  
schooling in said town to the northeast corner  
of said school lot thence north far enough  
to contain one hundred and twenty acres  
of said ministerial lot by a line parallel  
with the south line of said lot

To Have and to Hold the same to the said White his

heirs and assigns, to their use and benefit forever. And I do covenant with the  
said ~~Lang~~ White his heirs and assigns, That I am law-  
fully seized in fee of the premises—That they are free of all incumbrances—That I  
have good right to sell and convey the same to the said ~~Lang~~ White his  
And that I will warrant and defend the same to the said ~~Lang~~ White his  
heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of any persons.
