Did EGW use liver for medicinal purposes?

Dear Brother Douglass:

I have just received your letter. It is always a pleasure to hear from you. We have nothing from Sister White's pen which indicated that she used liver for medicinal purposes. As you look through the statements as they relate to the use of flesh foods in Counsels on Diet and Foods, you will find that Sister White did recognize that there were exceptional situations which justified the use of flesh food. After 1895 when she took a teetotal stand on the question of the use of flesh food, she did not use it. Reports that she used it in the later years of her life were not true. So inasmuch as the statements you are looking for do not exist, there is not much that we can do to help you, except to give this information.

I am off for Europe in a few days. We shall have Extension School in England for six weeks beginning June 1, and another in Norway beginning in mid-July.
