

Domestic WinePreservation of Grape Juice - 1869

Question: "If we have inferior grapes and apples that will not keep, is there any way of keeping the juices of them from changing to alcohol after being pressed out?"

Answer: "No way, except by means of ice. But we do not want to preserve the juice. It is the fruit only that should be preserved; and this may be done by drying, or in an ice house properly constructed."--
