My dear Brother

Some time ago, you wrote requesting information about a statement by Mrs. White that deals with the hidden tables of the law. Elder R. L. Odom, our Index editor, has prepared a worthwhile and readable comment on these Ellen G. White statements that we think will prove helpful to you in answering your inquiry. We are enclosing a dozen copies for you and for the members of the class considering this and related subjects. The charge will be simply the cost of labor and reproduction. I think \$1.00 would cover this expense.

I think, Brother Wright, that the statements by Mrs. White dealing with the hidden tables of the law, will meet their fulfillment in the day of the Lord and not during probationary time. I think that it will be ill-advised to recommend that anyone look for the rediscovery of the hidden tables of stone this side of the close of probation. But it will be within the providence of God, it seems, that there should be a great unveiling of the law of God at the second coming of Christ and at the close of the millennium in connection with the great triumph of God's kingdom and the vindication of God's law and character.
