Dear Brother

A long time ago you submitted to me a document entitled, "Valuable Un-published Testimonies of Mrs. E. G. White- extracts from a vision at Dorchester Mass, Oct. 23 1850."

In your letter of November 25, you ask me to express my opinion as to whether it is a genuine document.

As I read it I remember having seen it before. I think it was sent to me once a long time ago as a copy of notes taken of mother's utterances while in vision.

It reads much more like the notes taken by our brethren of her broken utterances while in vision than anything else. It doesn't sound like her regularly.

In the early days our brethren used to furnish mother with notes taken of her utterances while in vision and these she used as a reminder to help her in writing out the view.

I have no knowledge of this document that would enable me to say that it is correct or incorrect but this I am free to say. I would not advise our people to use it. It seems to me that the more full and complete statements which mother has written regarding these matters are more useful to us than the brief and incomplete statements of this document.
